

# The Cornmarket Project Wexford - DSP Drugs Rehab CE Model



The client is referred to the Cornmarket Project and is comprehensively assessed

Typically the client engages with one of the other services of the project i.e. Pre Training, Behaviour Change Programme, Counselling, Drop-In or Outreach first for a period of time, up to one year, in order to stabilise and become "CE Ready"



After a period of engagement with the project the client is referred in-house by their individual keyworker to our Drugs Rehab CE Scheme

The client is assessed for CE and offered a place if suitable or referred back into another service of the project if it is felt they are not yet ready



The client starts on CE but still has access to the other support services of the project i.e. Counselling, Outreach, Drop-In etc.

At this stage some clients may also be linked in with other agencies i.e. HSE Methadone or Mental Health services or the Probation Services etc.



The ten areas covered by the COAIM System and vital to full rehabilitation for CE clients are: Attitudes and Cognitive Style, Offending Behaviour, Pro-Social Activities, Anger and Emotion Management, Training and Employability, Accommodation, Lifestyle and Associates, Financial Issues, Relationships and Family Issues and Drug and Alcohol Misuse



In addition to the ILP, each client develops a progression route/relapse prevention plan based on priority areas identified through their engagement with our COAIM System - Change Outcome And Impact Measuring System



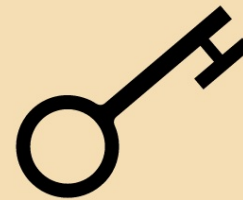
All clients on our CE engage in a range of in-house vocational skills work/training programmes and intensive therapeutic rehabilitation modules i.e. Motivational Enhancement and Relapse Prevention Skills. These programmes and modules are delivered by the Supervisors with additional input from other project staff



Based on the areas highlighted from ongoing assessment through the COAIM System, clients are case managed and linked in with appropriate other services i.e. Local Employment Service, SOLAS, TEB's, MAB's, Housing, HSE Mental Health, etc.



Clients on our Drugs Rehab CE are also given work placement opportunities on other mainstream CE schemes in Wexford, and with other employers



Clients remain drug free, exit the CE and reintegrate back into further mainstream training, education, employment and society in general
