Theme 1: Economic Development & Job Creation, budget to allocate: €2,574,558

Climate Change Capacity Building €80,000	That there is improved awareness and understanding of climate change.	<ul><li>Community climate action plans.</li><li>Climate action technical expertise.</li></ul>
